



Entry Level 3 Award in Mathematics Skills

This qualification was designed to provide learners with a flexible route to developing the skills in Mathematics which will enable them to build confidence and provide a foundation for further study towards a GCSE in Mathematics, a Functional Skill in Mathematics, a move into employment or as a stepping stone to higher level study.

It will provide learners with an opportunity to:

- Build their confidence and develop their skills in using mathematics.
- Achieve a standalone qualification that offers a route to further learning and gives recognition for progress in mathematics skills.
- Work in detail on identified areas of mathematics that need further development and to prepare the learner to progress on to other relevant qualifications such as Awards in Mathematics Skills at Level 1 and Level 2
- Gain the knowledge and skills required to prepare for further learning and employment and to make progress in their function at home, work and in the community. The qualification links to the Adult Numeracy Core Curriculum and are underpinned by the national standards for Adult Numeracy. The qualifications allow the development of learners' skills so they have the underpinning knowledge to progress onto Functional Skills qualifications.

Entry Requirements

There are no formal entry requirements for learners undertaking this qualification and it is suitable for learners **aged 16 years and over**.
